

**RULE IMPACT STATEMENT
LAKE RULES 300:35 [AMENDED]**

1. **DESCRIPTION:** The proposed amendments modify the procedures for service of a Notice of Violation and a Final Order. Language regarding alcoholic beverages on Grand River Dam Authority land has been revised to correlate with Oklahoma state law. Additionally, other general clarifications have been made.
2. **CLASSES OF PERSONS AFFECTED:** Affected persons are members of the public, business entities, the Board of Directors, General Manager/Chief Executive Officer, other officers and employees of Grand River Dam Authority.
3. **CLASSES OF PERSONS BENEFITTED:** Members of the public and business entities benefit from the protections and regulations contained in the rules. The Board of Directors, General Manager/Chief Executive Officer, other officers and employees of Grand River Dam Authority benefit by the direction and consistency the rules provide.
4. **ECONOMIC IMPACT:** The proposed clarifications to the rules will not result in an economic impact.
5. **COST:** The proposed rules will not require more revenue than what is currently expended for lake related operations by Grand River Dam Authority.
6. **IMPACT ON POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS:** No burden will be placed on any political subdivision.
7. **ADVERSE EFFECT ON SMALL BUSINESS:** None.
8. **LESS COSTLY METHODS:** No less costly methods were identified.
9. **SIGNIFICANT RISKS:** None.
10. **DETRIMENTAL EFFECT:** None.
