he Grand River Dam Authority (GRDA) Police Department is proud to serve the State of Oklahoma in providing law enforcement and rescue services. The GRDA is the largest publicly-owned utility in the state and supplies bulk electricity and water to a large number of communities and Oklahomans. The primary mission of the GRDA Police is to provide 24 hour protection for our electrical and water delivery systems within the state.

As state-certified police officers, the personnel of GRDA Police also provide marine law enforcement and rescue services for several lakes in the northeast part of the state including Grand Lake, Lake Hudson, the W.R. Holway Reservoir, as well as the Neosho, Spring, Grand, Illinois and the Baron Fork Rivers.

While our primary service area lies within 24 counties in Northeast Oklahoma, our officers have jurisdiction through-



out the state of Oklahoma to provide protection and investigative services for GRDA assets across the state. Our agency prides itself on employing seasoned, highly-trained and skilled officers to ensure a professional approach in the delivery of our services.

As a state law enforcement agency, we are ready to assist our local and regional emergency responders with personnel and resources. In addition to being certified police officers, all GRDA Police personnel are trained and equipped in swift-water rescue, boat operations and as emergency medical responders.

All of our uniformed patrol officers operate winch equipped four-wheel drive vehicles with state and county radios, tactical and medical equipment.



GRDA Police also have the following equipment and resources available:

- Dive Team
- Rescue and Recovery Boats
- Helicopter equipped with FLIR & search light
- Utility-Terrain Vehicles
- Confined Space & Rope Rescue Team
- Peer Support Team

It is the goal of our agency to fulfill our mission of serving the state and providing valuable assets to other emergency response agencies in times of need.
